Testing	Students must meet the graduation requirements from the time of entry in 9th grade (i.e. earn required number of credits; pass OGT/proficiency, etc.)	Students do not have to pass the OGT/Proficiency test; however, they are required to pass the ACT WorkKeys at the median level for the field of study	GED = Computer Test; HSET = computer or pen & paper; TASC = computer or pen & paper
Duration	Maximum of 2 consecutive years to complete program	Program duration depends on the Remediation time for WorkKeys, if needed, plus the length of the credential program (usually 3 to 18 months total)	All prep work is completed at your own pace. Testing is completed in two to four hour intervals on multiple days by appointment
Requirements	Number of high school credits required depends on requirements when student entered 9th grade. Limit of 2 consecutive years for a student to earn recovery credits. Recommend for those with no more than 7 total credits needed and no more than 2 OGT/proficiency tests needed.	No minimum number of high school credits required. Based on passing WorkKeys at median level for the field of work studied with a total WorkKeys score of 13 or higher.	No minimum number of high school credits required. All testing is skills based. TASC = Good for those just wanting a diploma or to maintain current job or improve position in current field of work. In process of alignment with CORE standards.
